



Progress Report #8 *July 26, 2007*

Construction of the Pinnacle is well under way and rapidly proceeding, changing the landscape at the corner of Capitol and Lamar daily. Over 450 auger-cast piles have been drilled 58 feet below grade and filled with over 2,000 yards of concrete. On top of these piles we have formed and poured 23 pile caps. Within the pile caps we have placed over 1,500 yards of concrete and 100 tons of steel reinforcement. Concrete columns which will ultimately frame the grand 30 foot lobby are also being put into place. These elements working together insure the Pinnacle will have a solid foundation for years to come.

“The Pinnacle construction is progressing nicely and the foundation work is setting the tone for the first class project we have come to expect,” said Jack Sullenberger, Senior Vice President of Technical Services for Parkway Properties, Inc. “It is the first step in assuring the Pinnacle will offer the finest office environment in the state for its customers.”
