



## *Progress Report #9 September 2, 2007*

A significant component of the Jackson Place master plan, the conversion of the *Parking at Jackson Place* from city ownership to Parkway Properties, commenced September 1, 2007. Parkway will immediately begin a \$4.5 million renovation of the facility which includes an upgrade of the lighting system, followed by waterproofing and painting the entire facility, revamping stairwells and elevators, and installing a new façade on the ground level with new exterior signage. Upon completion of The Pinnacle at Jackson Place in late 2008, the entrance to the parking facility will be extended and a climate-controlled walkway will be added to connect the facility with One Jackson Place and The Pinnacle. Retail shops on the first floor are also being planned.

John Gifford, Vice President of Parkway and Asset Manager for Jackson said, “It is our goal to provide the most parking-friendly environment in Jackson that exceeds our customers’ expectations. Through our newly adopted Parking Bill of Rights, we commit to provide a high standard of operation, promote a professional attitude and deliver superior customer service to our parking customers.”
